# DECK TILE SYSTEM

## Assembly and Maintenance

Iron Woods® Deck Tiles were developed to ensure easy installation. To assemble, simply lay out your tile pattern, line up the interlocking quick connectors and press the tiles together. Our floating design requires no nails or adhesives and allows for proper drainage. The Iron Woods® Deck Tiles system comes prefinished with our First Coat wood sealer. To preserve the natural color of your tiles, all that's required is to reapply a clear penetrating oil-based sealer as needed.

To calculate the approximate number of tiles needed for your project, you will need to determine the square footage of the area by multiplying the length times the width. Then simply multiply the total square footage by 1.10 to get the number of tiles required for your project. For example, a 4' by 12' balcony is 48 square feet (4x12=48). Then, take 48 square feet x 1.10 and round up (48x1.10 = 52.8). Approx. 53 tiles are required to cover example project. It may require more or less depending on installation method.

## Borders

To complete a perfectly finished corner or edge, Timber Holdings offers an inside and outside corner border (sold in pairs), or a straight border.
